



Wedding Albums



Everyone has a story to tell, our business has been about crafting those stories into beautiful objects to remember forever. But the way we do so has been changing dramatically. Instead of traditional photographic printing, we use digital offset technology to create – not beautiful albums, but beautiful books.



To order an album you start by making several choices – format (size), cover material, cover style and page type. Your first and most important decision is the “format” – the size and shape of the album.



We offer a wide range of natural and man-made cover materials, including genuine full-grain leathers, man-made micro-leathers, silks, buckrams and vinyls. Having selected a cover material you can choose a cover style from a variety of Cover Motifs and Photo Front covers, or you may prefer a blind embossed or plain cover, padded or unpadded.



We offer four page types: **Pagemount**, **Overlay** or **Duo** pages (all matted) or **Digital** pages (un-matted).

Overlay pages are the traditional way to present an album. The photograph is lightly taped behind the matted board with the print edge concealed behind it, giving the pages a classic look. We have six mat colours to choose from. The pages are supplied with protective edging and corners in black, white or silver.

Our unique **Pagemount pages** have a layered border effect around the photographs. The border is created by trimming the prints slightly smaller than the matted opening to reveal the coloured base page. We have eleven base page colours to choose from, which you can see in your photographer's Swatch Book. As with Overlay, you have a choice of six mat colours, and protective edging and corners in black, white or silver.

Digital pages represent the ultimate. Your photographer has actual samples to view in our Page Sampler and Swatch Book.

Duos are our signature product. They enable you to combine Matted and Digital pages in the same album, and to bleed images out to the edge of matted pages on one or more sides. Duo albums have no corners or edging. We trim the page block after assembly to maintain the smooth-edge look of a Digital album. The finished product combines contemporary style with the elegance of classical techniques.

You can display your prints either Pagemount or Overlay style on matted Duo pages, but you can't mix styles in the same album.



We offer one personalised album title with all Matted Feature Albums. For practical reasons titles are not available in digital albums. There are a variety of styles, including translucent interleaves and printed inserts designed to fit apertures on the matted page
